Transportation

Arrival and Departure

International Airports: **Frankfurt-Main** (best train connections!), Stuttgart and Zürich (Switzerland). Other airports could be Frankfurt-Hahn, Basel (France-Switzerland) or Strasbourg (France).

Train Connections to Offenburg

Frankfurt International Airport has got a train station dubbed "Long-Distance-Trains" (Fernbahnhof) from which Offenburg is conveniently reached within 1 hour and 45 minutes approximately. ICE trains to Offenburg with main destination Freiburg/Basel (Switzerland) are departing nearly every hour.

There are a few ICE trains providing direct connection to Offenburg yet in most cases you'll have to change trains once in Mannheim which is the first halt after departure from Frankfurt. In Mannheim your connecting train to Offenburg (an ICE as well) is usually departing from the opposite platform of your arrival.

In front of Offenburg train station there are taxis to take you to your hotel which is usually reached within about 15 to 20 minutes.
